### **CHARGING POLICY**

#### **PURPOSE:**

This Charging Policy informs staff and parents about charging for School activities. It conforms to the requirements of the Education Reform Act 1988.

#### **RESPONSIBILITIES:**

The Governors, in consultation with the Head, are responsible for the implementation of the charging policy and the determination of any individual case arising from the implementation of this policy.

#### **RELATED DOCUMENTS:**

Following the requirements of the Education Reform Act of 1988, no charge will be made for books, materials, equipment and instruction in connection with the national Curriculum, except where parents have indicated in advance their wish to purchase the product. Parents of pupils on income support or Family credit are entitled to a remission of charges on in-school or part in-school activities.

#### **ORGANISATION:**

Voluntary Contributions are requested from parents for school activities in or out of school time which can only be provided if there is sufficient voluntary funding. No pupils shall be excluded by reason of inability or unwillingness to make a voluntary contribution.

Parents are asked to make a contribution towards replacing damaged or lost school property caused wilfully or negligently by their children.

A voluntary contribution is requested by the staff to help meet the costs of baking activities and snack money in the nursery. The amount requested will be adjusted annually in line with actual costs.
